## **Qualifications for Holding Office**

If you have any questions regarding your ability to hold office, please ask the County Clerk or the Wyoming Secretary of State's office for clarification.

- (i) Is a resident of the legislative district on the date he files an application under W.S. 22-5-204 or a petition under W.S. 22-5-301; and
- (ii) Has been a resident of a county for at least one (1) year next preceding his election in which any portion of that legislative district is located.

#### Please ensure that:

- ✓ You're not holding an office that may conflict, or be incompatible, with the office for which you are filing.
- ✓ Your employment is not incompatible with the office you are seeking.

#### **STATE SENATOR**

- Must be at least 25 years old
- U.S. Citizen
- **Oualified Elector**
- Resided in the district from which elected at least twelve months next preceding their election W.S. 22-5-102(a)

### STATE REPRESENTATIVE

- Must be at least 21 years old
- U.S. Citizen
- **Qualified elector**
- Resided in the district from which elected at least twelve months next preceding his election. W.S. 22-5-102(a)

In any general election year in which legislative reapportionment is required but has not been enacted into law at least one (1) year prior to the applicable filing periods, a person may be a candidate for the state legislature from a legislative district if he/she is a resident of the legislative district on the date they file their application for nomination and, have been a resident of a county for at least one (1) year next preceding their election in which any portion of that legislative district is located.
