Secretary Murray and Lieutenant Governors Gather to Discuss Key State Issues

CHEYENNE, WY – Wyoming Secretary of State Ed Murray met with lieutenant governors, secretaries of state, and other national leaders at the National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) Business Meeting in Arizona this week. As Secretary of State, Ed Murray serves as the constitutionally designated successor to the Governor, and is one of only three secretaries of state in the United States who serve in that capacity.

“I was honored to meet with national leaders on cybersecurity, border security, drug enforcement policy, and other important topics which affect Wyoming and every other state,” said Secretary Murray. “My counterparts and I discussed possible changes coming to states under the new presidential administration and we discussed ongoing regional collaboration.”

The gathering of lieutenant governors and secretaries of state also discussed opportunities and challenges in international affairs and trade, as well as methods to make running a statewide office more efficient and effective.

“As Wyoming’s Secretary of State, I am always seeking new insights for Wyoming in health, education, job training, and stewardship of our precious resources,” said Secretary Murray.
