Wyoming State Canvassing Board to Certify Election Results on November 16

CHEYENNE, WY – Wyoming Secretary of State Ed Murray will chair the Wyoming State Canvassing Board on November 16th. The Board will meet to review the election results from across Wyoming, address any issues encountered, and certify as official the election results and the winning candidates.

“Congratulations to all Wyoming voters for setting a new record for total ballots cast during this year's general election! I am thrilled that over 258,000 Wyoming citizens participated in the voting process. I am looking forward to finalizing and certifying the election results with the Canvassing Board next week,” said Secretary Murray.

The Board will meet at 10:00 am on Wednesday, November 16th in the Wyoming Department of Transportation's auditorium. Members of the Board are: Governor Matt Mead; Secretary of State Ed Murray (chairman); State Auditor Cynthia Cloud; and State Treasurer Mark Gordon.

The Secretary of State's Office works closely with Wyoming's 23 County Clerks in overseeing and administering Wyoming's elections. Each county's election results are first canvassed by county-level canvassing boards before being submitted to the Secretary of State's Office.
