## Secretary of State's Office Offers Training on Online Filing of Campaign Finance Reports

**CHEYENNE, WY** – The Secretary of State's Office will conduct workshops aimed at assisting state-level candidates, candidate committees, political action committees, organizations, and political parties with electronic filing of their campaign finance disclosure reports.

“Our goal in offering this hands-on training is to ensure that every candidate understands the legal requirements of campaign finance reporting. By providing this training during the 2016 Election Cycle, our team in the Election Division hopes to make this process as easy as possible for the candidates,” said Secretary of State Ed Murray.

The workshops will be offered on June 14th at Casper College from 6:00-8:00 p.m.; June 15th at Laramie County Community College (LCCC) in Cheyenne from 6:00-8:00 p.m.; and again in Cheyenne at LCCC from 3:00-5:00 p.m. Candidates for state and legislative office, campaign committee representatives, and political party representatives wishing to attend must register by June 8th by calling (307) 777-5860 or emailing [campaignfinance@wyo.gov](mailto:campaignfinance@wyo.gov).

Electronic filing of state campaign finance reports has been required since January 2010. State-level candidates, candidate and political action committees, organizations, and political parties electronically file their reports on the Secretary of State's web-based Wyoming Campaign Finance Information System (WYCFIS).
