Secretary of State's Office Moving to Office Space in Herschler Building

CHEYENNE, WY – Between August 23rd and August 26th, the [Wyoming Secretary of State's Office will move](#) from its temporary location in downtown Cheyenne to the Herschler Building. The Office's new location will be adjacent to the recently renovated Wyoming State Capitol.

"The Secretary of State's Office serves thousands of customers each year in-person. We are unique among state offices for the continuous interactions with the public that we have every day of the week. My staff takes great pride in providing stellar customer service for each and every person who visits the Secretary of State's Office. The Secretary of State's Office has been located at 2020 Carey Avenue since November, 2015. When extensive renovations to the capitol building began, the Secretary of State's Office left the Wyoming State Capitol where the Office had been originally located since before statehood. With renovations to the Wyoming State Capitol complete, the Office will now relocate to the first floor of the Herschler Building.

The Secretary of State's Office at the Wyoming Financial Center on Carey Avenue will close at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, August 23rd, and reopen on Tuesday, August 27th with regular hours at the Office's new location.
