

Chapter VIII Temporary Location

Section 1. Definition. Means a place licensed where cosmetology and related fields may be practiced for no longer than two (2) weeks or fourteen (14) days by persons licensed to perform cosmetology and related services on a person.

Section 2. Application and License. No person, association, partnership or corporation may operate in a temporary location without first securing a license from the Board. Applications shall be made on the prescribed form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. The completed application shall include or be accompanied by the following information.

- (a) The name and address of the applicant
- (b) The complete address of the proposed temporary location.
- (c) A list of services being provided
- (d) Date and times of operation during the license period.
- (e) Detailed summary of disinfection and infection control procedures.
- (f) List of licensees and their license numbers for those providing services.
- (g) All licensees performing services must have a board issued original copy of their license, wet disinfection standards and sanitation rules and regulations posted at the temporary location.
